FROM THE WEST:

1. Proceed on Route 376 (Direction of Monroeville) to the Squirrel Hill/Homestead Exit (immediately before the Squirrel Hill Tunnels).
2. Follow signs in the direction of Homestead....eventually you will cross the Monongahela River....continue straight to the top of the hill.
3. At the end of this road, turn right onto West Run Rd....proceed about 1 mile.
4. St. John Cathedral will be on the right.

FROM THE EAST:

Follow Route 22 to Route 376 West
(Direction of Pittsburgh)

Proceed through the Squirrel Hill Tunnels and immediately after the tunnels, take the Squirrel Hill/Homestead Exit

Follow directions from #2 above.....

FROM THE SOUTH:

Follow Route 79 North to Pittsburgh

Follow signs for Route 376 East (Direction of Monroeville)

FROM THE NORTH:

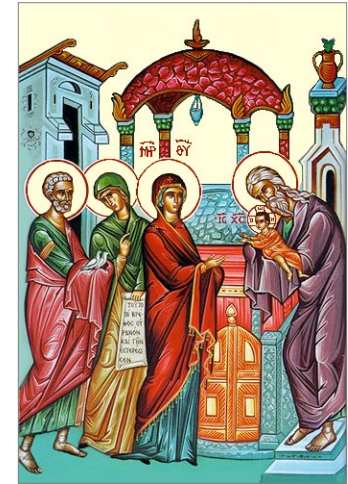
Follow Route 79 South to Route 279 South
